HE STILL HEALS

with Dr. Kynan Bridges

Many Christians believe God can heal, but they are not convinced He will heal them. Why is it so difficult for believers to receive what Scripture already promises?

KB: Wrong theology is the culprit behind this insidious belief. Theology informs us about the nature and character of God. When there is a bad theological framework, people don't believe that God is omnibenevolent and that it is His unconditional will to heal.

Jesus healed everywhere He went, yet many churches rarely preach on healing today. Has the Church quietly lowered its expectations of what God still wants to do?

KB: Unfortunately, there is a dangerous doctrine of cessationism that has affected people's expectation concerning what God can and will do. This is why so many churches don't expect God to move supernaturally. But Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

You teach that healing is part of our covenant in Christ. How does understanding that truth change the way we pray when sickness attacks our bodies?

KB: When we understand our covenantal rights, we will approach healing with boldness and authority. If you know that you have comprehensive insurance, the best in class, you will approach the claim boldly because you know you are adequately insured. The same is true of our spiritual lives. Jesus paid the premium for our health and wholeness in full; claim your healing in Jesus' name.

What are some of the biggest misconceptions you have encountered about divine healing that actually keep people from receiving their miracle?

KB: The belief that God will not heal everyone or that sickness is used by God to teach us a lesson. The devil is a liar!

Well-meaning Christians sometimes tell people they're still sick because they don't have enough faith or because they're doing something wrong spiritually. What would you say to someone who's carrying both the pain of illness and the weight of those accusations?

KB: I would encourage them to stop listening to the lies of the enemy. You have all the faith you need to receive from God and walk in His promises. Approach His throne boldly and receive your healing.

Some people assume every sickness is purely physical, while others assume every illness is a demon. How do we discern the difference, and why is that distinction so important?

KB: Many illnesses are not physical at all. Sometimes people are dealing with something spiritual, mental, or emotional that is affecting their health. The good news is that Jesus addressed every root cause of sickness and disease on the cross. Also, sometimes believers are not experiencing the blessing of health and wholeness because they are not stewarding their temple (their body) well. Believing God for healing, while dishonoring Him with your habits and lifestyle, is counterintuitive.

Jesus asked some people, "Do you want to be made well?" That seems like an unusual question. Why would someone knowingly or unknowingly resist their own healing?

KB: Sometimes, people can be discouraged and abdicate their authority to receive their healing. The man at the pool of Bethesda was in this particular predicament. Jesus was challenging the man's will to receive from God.

Some believers have stopped praying for healing because they were taught miracles passed away with the apostles. What would you say to someone who sincerely believes healing isn't for today?

KB: They need to go back and read the Bible. God still believes in healing today and so should we!

Is there a healing testimony you have witnessed that completely challenged your own understanding of what God is able to do?

KB: Yes. I saw a woman that had melanoma be totally healed in less than 48 hours. Every cancerous growth on her body fell off in that time frame without chemotherapy or any medical intervention.

If someone reading today desperately needs healing, what practical steps can they begin taking today to position themselves to receive from God?

KB: The first thing they need to do is meditate on the Word of God and get the Word in their spirit. This will build their faith to receive from Heaven. Second, they need to get a copy of *They Shall Be Healed* to begin to apply their faith to receive.

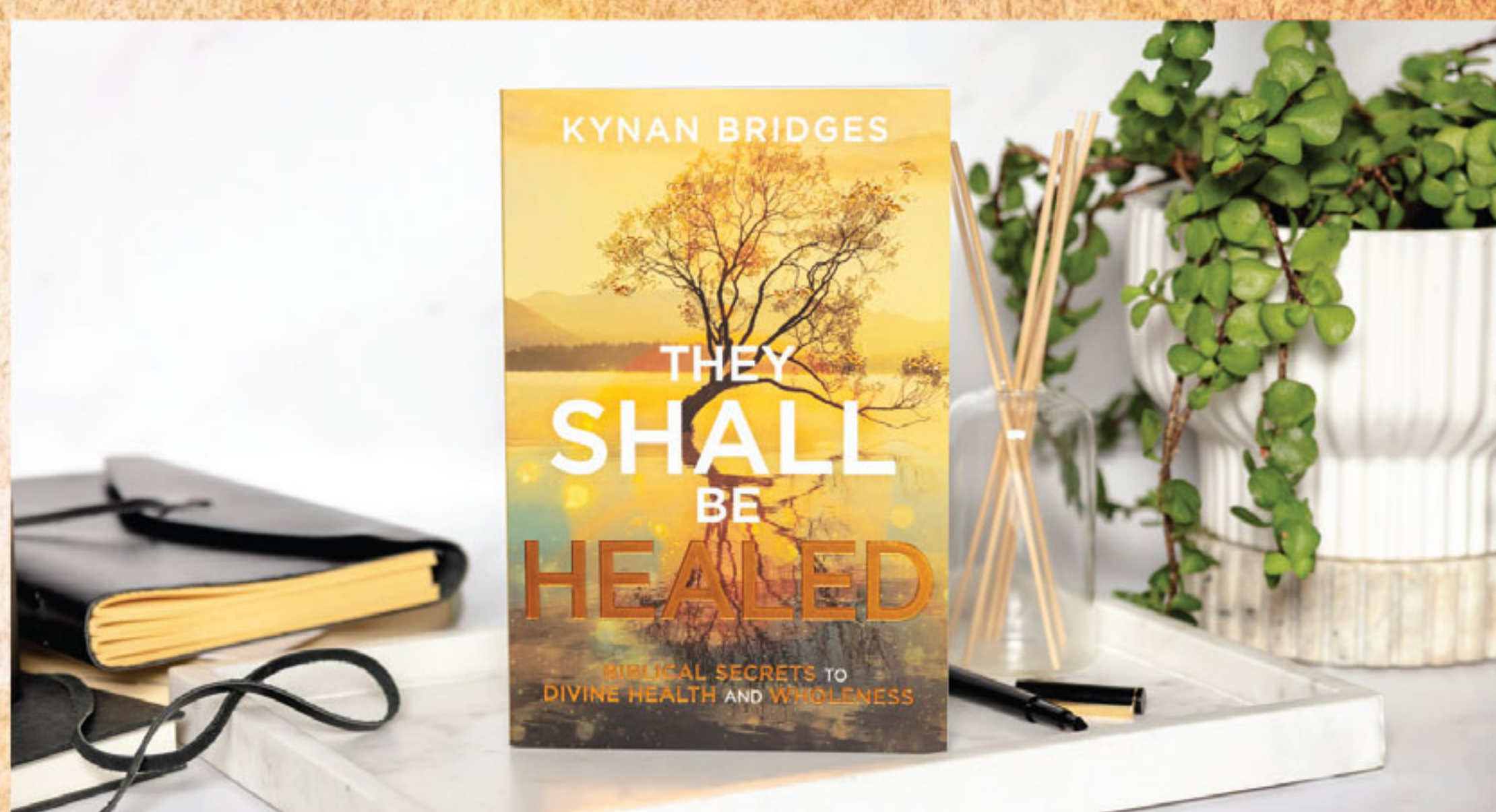

YOM KIPPUR

Every fall, Jewish people around the world observe Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement. It is considered the most holy day on the biblical calendar, a day set apart for repentance, prayer, fasting, and seeking God.

But Yom Kippur isn't only significant to understanding Jewish tradition. For Christians, it offers a powerful picture of what Jesus accomplished for us on the cross.

God established the Day of Atonement in Leviticus 16 and commanded Israel to observe it on the tenth day of the seventh month. Once a year, the high priest entered the Holy of Holies with sacrificial blood to make atonement for the sins of the people. One goat was sacrificed, while another—the “scapegoat”—symbolically carried Israel's sins away.

Year after year, the ceremony was repeated. Then came Jesus. Hebrews reveals the incredible connection: Jesus became our perfect High Priest and offered not the blood of animals, but **His own blood**. Unlike the sacrifices offered repeatedly under the Old Covenant, His sacrifice was made **once for all**, securing eternal redemption.

Yom Kippur pointed forward to a day when our sin would not simply be covered, it would be dealt with through the finished work of Christ.

Scriptures to Read on Yom Kippur

- **Leviticus 16:29–34** — God establishes the Day of Atonement.
- **Isaiah 53:4–6** — The Messiah bears our sin.
- **Hebrews 9:11–14** — Jesus enters the Most Holy Place with His own blood.
- **Hebrews 10:10–14** — Christ's sacrifice is sufficient once for all.
- **1 John 1:9** — God promises forgiveness and cleansing when we confess.

As Christians, we don't need to repeat the sacrifices of Yom Kippur because **Jesus fulfilled what those sacrifices pointed toward**. But we can still set apart this biblical holy day to remember and worship.

Consider spending time in **prayer and fasting**, allowing the Lord to search your heart. Confess areas of sin, forgive those who have wronged you, read the Scriptures above, and thank Jesus specifically for the price He paid for your redemption. You might also spend time **praying for Israel and the Jewish people**, that they would encounter their Messiah.

Yom Kippur reminds us both of the seriousness of sin and the overwhelming goodness of God's mercy.

The price has been paid. The sacrifice has been made. And because of Jesus, **we can boldly enter the presence of God fully forgiven and forever redeemed. Thank You, Jesus!**
